

Adopt a Family for Christmas

Only a couple of weeks left! For our new families to the parish here is a little explanation of how the program works. Sponsors (Parishioners who wish to help another family from this Parish) are given information about their chosen family. If you want a tax receipt for your donation than you can write a cheque St. Gregory's Church and mark it "Adopt A Family". The bookkeeper will then write a cheque for the amount and our Parish Secretary will go out and purchase the gifts/gift cards for the family.

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT



The second Sunday of Advent gives us the opportunity to **prepare our hearts in faithful waiting**, celebrate the birth of Jesus, and ready ourselves for his second coming.

<u>Psalm 46:10-11</u> says: "...Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth." The Lord Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress."

This week, we pause to remember who God is and what He has done for us. When our lives are hurried, we only have the chance to focus on our to-do lists. Making space in our schedules for prayer and meditation helps us to better see God at work in our lives and in our world.

As we prepare our hearts for the celebration of Jesus' arrival as a gift to all humanity, let's stir up in our hearts and homes a sense of anticipation. Worth Noting

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.) provides instruction and spiritual formation to anyone 16 years of age and older who are not baptized, or baptized in another Christian community, who would like to become a member of the Catholic Church. Catholic adults who have not yet received their First Holy Communion or the Sacrament of Confirmation may also take part. Please speak to Fr.
