

I intend to use these funds to pay our debt and for future renovation and maintenance.

Parish Day of Reconciliation

Annual visit to the elderly and sick

Please let know Fr. Marijan if you have an elderly or sick person at home who can't come to church so that Fr. Marijan can visit and give yearly Anointing of the Sick, hear confession, give Communion, and God's blessing.

Updates on Covid-19 Restrictions:

- Indoor masking requirements end in churches, parish halls and offices starting on Monday, March 21, 2022 (Please wear your mask if you feel more comfortable)
- Churches can currently rent their halls, and food/drink can currently be served in halls, provided that people wear masks when standing; people should be seated to eat or drink, so they can take their masks off, as is the case in restaurants
- Starting Monday, March 21, all Covid-19 restrictions end in our parish halls
- Starting on Monday, March 21, restrictions on choir activities end
- Starting on March 21, individuals aged 18 and older, who have received their Covid-19 booster shot and who are asymptomatic for Covid, do not need to self-isolate when they are in close contact with someone who tests positive for Covid-19 (including if the sick person is a member of their household). The self-isolations requirement is also lifted for those younger than 18 years old who are asymptomatic and who have had two Covid-19 vaccine doses. If you meet these criteria, for 10 days you must wear a mask in public, refrain from elective visits to medical settings and avoid physical contact with those who are vulnerable to Covid
- Those who do not meet the above criteria and who have a Covid-19 close contact, must continue to self-isolate according to current provincial regulations


