

Dear Brothers and Sisters of Christ,

Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen once said, "Unless there is a Good Friday in your

life, there can be no Easter Sunday." This, and every other Holy Week through the liturgies of the Church we draw closer to Jesus in His Passion, so that we may be more closely united to Him in His Resurrection. Meditating on Christ's Passion is one way to bring ourselves to Christ in His Passion and Resurrection. Thus, singers sing, 'Were you there when they crucified my Lord? Were you there when they crucified my Lord? Oh, sometimes it causes me to tremble, tremble, tremble. Were you there when they crucified my Lord? [...] Were you there when they nailed him to the tree? [...] Were you there when they laid him in the tomb? [...] Were you there when God raised him from the tomb?" (African-American spiritual; public domain) With singers we try to bring not only our minds to Jesus in His Passion, but also our whole selves, seeking to unite ourselves to the suffering Jesus, Jesus crucified, and dead, so that we may rise with Him. This is what I wish to you and your dear ones, to resurrect with Jesus in the power of His glorified life from whatever is causing you to be discouraged, down, and as if dead: your relationships, struggles, and your perhaps aching heart. Christ was also discouraged, down, and dead, but He rose from all of that. Bring your life and heart to Jesus, so that He may restore your relationships, help you with your struggles, heal your heart, and make your life whole by the power of His Resurrection! Happy Easter to you and your Family.
