

"We realize how true this is at those moments when we feel hopeless, wandering through life like a desert and lacking a promised land as our destination. Lent is the season of grace in which the desert can become once more — in the words of the prophet Hosea — the place of our first love."

The new PA Day of Monday, April 8, 2024, is in effect for elementary and secondary schools across the board. This change is due to a total solar eclipse taking place on Monday, April 8.
