Extraordinary Graces of Divine Mercy

"In three places in her Diary, St. Faustina records our Lord's promises of specific, extraordinary graces:

- -I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession [beforehand] and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy (#1109).
- -Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life [Eucharist] on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (#300).
- -The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (#699)." https://www.thedivinemercy.org/

That is, one may go straight to Heaven if one dies soon after confessing well and receiving Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday.

A plenary of partial indulgence may also be obtained.

SSVP News – Summer Camp

The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul operates two overnight camps for Children, Marygrove Camp for girls and Camp Ozanam for boys. Marygrove welcomes girls aged 5 to 13 for an 8-day camping adventure on the shores of Georgian Bay and Camp Ozanam welcomes boys aged 7 to 12 for a 7-day camping adventure on Deer Lake in South River. Both camps are free to eligible families. The criteria are fairly broad and are focused on children who might not otherwise have the opportunity to attend summer camp which might include families who cannot afford the cost of a camp or who can't take a vacation due to restricted income, illness, lack of funds etc. While all children who would enjoy and benefit from a wholesome outdoor experience are welcome, we lack the staffing resources to deal with children who suffer severe emotional or physical problems, life threatening allergies or serious medical conditions. Marygrove sessions run from July 4th to August 27th and Ozanam runs from July 15 to Aug 13th. Anyone interested should call 905-720-0003 and ask to speak to the camp coordinator.
